

**ADDENDUM TO MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
CONCERNING THE SHARING OF INFORMATION
RELATED TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE
BUREAU OF CONSUMER FINANCIAL PROTECTION**

Pursuant to Section IV.1 of the Memorandum of Understanding Concerning the Sharing of Information Related to the Establishment of the Bureau of Consumer Financial Protection (MOU) dated April 8, 2011, the Office of the Comptroller of Currency and the Bureau of Consumer Financial Protection hereby reaffirm their commitment to be bound by and comply with the terms of the MOU after the designated transfer date under section 1062 of Title X of the Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act. The sharing of information under the MOU may therefore continue unless and until the parties amend the MOU pursuant to Section IV.3 or any party gives written notice of its intent to terminate the MOU pursuant to Section IV.1.
